



# **DESCRIPTION OF THE TRANSMITTER FUNCTIONS**

# 23120035 - 23120040 - 23120025 - 23120030 receiver code learning

- Put radio receiver jumper 1 or jumper 2 off corresponding to relay output that you want to put on (J1 for Channel 1 and J2 for Channel 2).
- Push S1 self-learning button for 1/2 second at least, the Led will light.

- Push your T button on the radio transmitter.
- Take the jumper off.
- Check the store in by giving a command.

# Each relay output has to be on with only one jumper

Please note: If no compatible command is sent within 18 seconds from learning mode (led flashing) a safe timer brings the circuit back to normal function (led off)

## Key button erase operation from a radio receiver

- Turn the radio jumper off if on (B.O. mode) corresponding to the relay output you're going to put
- Put learning on acting on radio receiver S1 button.
- Start the transmitter by turning the button key into erasing key.
- The Led will start flashing while deleting.

## **Battery Saver**

Each key button 23103025 module includes a Battery Saver to inactive a radio transmission, that lasts more than 2 seconds for any reason.

## **MAINTENANCE**

The only maintenance applicable to this product is battery replacing if it's not working or the voltage is very poor.
